This role is a central part of a global network of expert organisations (YBI members), collaborating to tackle the critical challenges facing underserved young entrepreneurs around the world. The Director of D&P will lead an experienced and talented team to successfully capitalise on a wealth of opportunities and will play a critical role in driving YBI's strategy, allowing YBI to double its reach, encourage social impact and become the leading voice on youth entrepreneurship through increased funding and impactful programmes.



Role Purpose

- To drive YBI's income growth as part of the 2023-2025 strategy, taking an entrepreneurial approach to developing unrestricted income sources and diversifying/growing the organisation's portfolio of high-value partnerships;
- To lead the strategic design and co-creation of compelling funder propositions and impactful programmes for our global network and ensure their effective delivery.
- To contribute to positioning the YBI externally and leveraging influence within the entrepreneurial ecosystem to deliver the organisation's strategy

Key Responsibilities

1. Organisational Leadership and Strategy

- Play an active and collaborative role with the Senior Management Team to develop and lead strategy development and execution across the organisation, share responsibility for the overall management of the organisation and role model the organisation's values, currently focused on YBI's significant growth in impact, membership and income across 2023-2025.
- As part of SMT take responsibility for the YBI Network Team's sustainability ensuring donors, members and all other stakeholders are engaged and that strategic decisions will meet their needs
- Promote and role model a collaborative, cross-departmental approach across the Network Team and work collaboratively with the Chair and Board of Trustees on strategic priorities and income growth
- Foster, promote and support inclusion at YBI by initiating and contributing to any organisational Diversity and Inclusion efforts
- Developing and maintaining authentic, trusting and transparent relationships with members/key stakeholders

2. Team leadership and management

- Working closely with the Heads of Development and Programmes, lead strategic and operational planning in business development and programme management, planning and effectively directing complex/high risk work streams and programmes that have substantial impact on YBI
- Provide clear direction, high quality line management, pastoral support and personal development to direct reports, in line with YBI's strategy and values, ensuring that all team members work collaboratively to deliver on the department's objectives

3. Business Development

• Lead the development and execution of YBI's income growth strategy, taking an entrepreneurial approach to developing unrestricted income sources including with HNWI and diversifying/growing the organisation's portfolio of high-value partnerships (including corporates, trusts/foundation, and institutional funding)



- Lead creative, strategic design thinking to cocreate with D&P, the SMT and the wider Network Team to transform strategic priorities and activities into compelling, fundable programmes, products and services that deliver value for YBI and its stakeholders
- Lead the development of a strategic funding pipeline, across all income sources, and with the CEO and D&P Heads, the prospecting for new funders through research, networking, building relationships, and inspiring and building confidence in YBI's mission and impact; to confidently develop and deliver high quality pitches to potential funders and investors
- Lead and/or oversee the development of high-quality, persuasive cases for investment/funding proposals tailored to specific donors
- Lead, with other SMT members, the activation of a new EU-based foundation, building strategic relationships and identifying funding opportunities with the EU.
- Ensure that appropriate systems are in place to support the delivery of business development activities

4. Programme Management

- Work with the relevant Head of D&P to lead YBI's programme management to
 ensure all programme commitments are robustly planned, managed, delivered and
 evaluated on time and to budget, with direct leadership on significant partnerships;
 review and evolve the approach as necessary
- Oversee all relevant teams are clear about their responsibilities/accountabilities, including management processes to ensure that delivery is smooth and that risks are actively managed
- Build strong relationships with programme funders to ensure mutually beneficial engagement, understand their future priorities and create the scope for expansion of the partnerships
